LIBRARY NETWORK MANAGER'S LOWDOWN

The transition to the new building on Commerce Street was successful. Thanks to all of the County agencies that made the move successful. Special thanks go out to Management Information Systems and Facilities for all of their work in making the transition as painless as possible.

Another item of note is that utilizing TRACE seems to be causing more problems than it is solving. At this point both the Circulation group and the Cataloging group seem to be on board with scrapping it in favor of something that will work better with Symphony. Unfortunately when items are checked out to TRACE and automatically converted to MISSING the location changes but Symphony does not actually check the item out to MISSING. This causes problems. Steps will still have to be taken to manage the items already checked out to TRACE.

Symphony has also been upgraded to 3.4.1 Service Pack 2. Once again Chanel executed a very smooth Symphony upgrade. Features that may benefit your library are the ability to see title-level holds from several of the cataloging wizards; the processing fee and lost item charge for lost items should now be removed from users at checkin; and patron due dates in e-Library now sort in chronological order. Other system fixes are in place that help administration of the system but have no direct impact on the libraries.

CVHS will be completed next week. Camp Verde USD is in the process of getting the SFTP client to work.

An initial set of questions to ask the Network Membership needs to be drafted.

PRIORITY: RFID INVENTORY SCANNER**PROGRESS: REPLACEMENT SCANNERS HAVE BEEN RECEIVED**

PPL and YLN have received the new scanner. YCP's is on the way. TechLogic will not create a utility to convert the reports gathered via the RFID scanner into a format Symphony understands. This means we will have to create our own utility and distribute it.

PRIORITY: SEPARATE POLICIES FROM PROCEDURES**PROGRESS: NONE**

The determination has been made that policies and procedures need to be separated out. Recently there has been some confusion as to the purpose of the Circulation manual and separating out the policies and procedures will provide the document with more focus.

PROGRESS: DATA RETENTION POLICY**PROGRESS: APPROVED**

The policy is approved; however, some tweaking is needed for some of the different library types.



NEW PRIORITIES

PRIORITY: BEGIN ANNUAL REPORT

Reason: The new agreement requires an annual report to be completed by the end of the year.

Reason: The new budget needs to be presented to the Steering Committee by January 15th, 2013.
