# Library Network Manager's Lowdown

The search for a new Online Public Access Catalog (OPAC) kicked off this month with a demo from SirsiDynix. They were showing the capabilities of their Enterprise software. Overall the product seemed like it would fit our needs. After the public demo, YLN staff had a separate virtual demo of the administrative side of the product. Administration seemed simple enough.

Chanel will have a demo in the beginning of June to demonstrate the capabilities of the VuFind OPAC. She has been working very hard on adding the features necessary for VuFind to work in our environment. The same script will be followed for her presentation and an evaluation form will be provided. Thanks to all of you for your assistance in the evaluation process.

We are also moving forward with replacing Syndetics with NoveList Select. NoveList Select has all the same enrichment features for the OPAC as Syndetics; however, it also adds in all of the NoveList Plus features directly into the item record. This means library users can get NoveList recommendations, series information, etc. without having to log into the NoveList database. We are using our current NoveList Plus subscription provided through the State of Arizona to upgrade to NoveList Select which is saving us money. Overall NoveList Select will provide us with far more features than Syndetics for just a little more money. K-8 features such as lexile ratings are also included.

The YLN in conjunction with the Yavapai County Free Library District (YCFLD) and the Mayer Unified School District (MUSD) won a Library Services and Technology Act grant to add the MUSD libraries into the consortium. Because of this grant, Yavapai County citizens will have access to Mayer Elementary School and Mayer High School library materials. This grant will also help the Mayer High School library reopen. The conversion of materials will occur over the summer.

The Telemessage (ITIVA) upgrade has been completed. Jim did a fantastic job working with Talking Tech, Yavapai County MIS Networking and SirsiDynix to get this project completed. He even managed to get more lines added. A special thanks to Jared Phelan for helping with this project as well. The previous incoming phone number has already been disconnected and is currently giving a message to those who call letting them know what the new number is. The recorded message will stop next month. The new phone numbers for patrons to call into are (928) 777-7476 and (928) 649-6250.

We have received all of the required items to start using the new inventory module from SirsiDynix. MobileCirc should be ready for beta testing next month (June). We also purchased an RFID reader to test it with the new system. My hope is that the miniature RFID antenna will remove the need for the ones just purchased through Tech Logic. If it is a viable alternative we will ask for a refund on the antennas purchased through Tech Logic. I will let you know more as I learn about the capabilities of the new MobileCirc system.

## Priority One: Resolve Current Helpdesk Requests

A help desk request, or work order, is the submission of a problem that one encounters during the normal operation of a YLN service. Requests are generally submitted via e-mail to help@yln.info. If a request is submitted via telephone than a YLN staff person will create the request for the submitter. Help desk requests will always be our highest priority because in some cases a member library employee cannot complete a work function until the issue is resolved.

## Priority Two: Expand Telemessage Access

The Telemessage (Itiva) system notifies library users via the telephone if they have an overdue item or an available hold. Library users can also call in to renew items, find out their bills, or just see what they have out. Currently the notification service is only available for PPL and PVPL.

**Goal:** Upgrade and expand the Telemessage service to include all public libraries within the local calling areas of Cottonwood and Prescott that desire the service.

**Project Lead:** Jim Lowman

### Progress:

- Upgrade server to Windows 2008 (1/30/13)
- Upgrade Telemessage to the latest version (1/30/13)
- Determine county telephone accessibility
- Add local line for the Verde Valley
- Start using new line and forward CoP line
- Transfer phone service to the county system
- Add additional libraries in Symphony
- Advertise new service
- Disconnect CoP line

## Priority Three: Add Additional Libraries

SirsiDynix has significantly reduced the cost of adding a library. The reduction in cost allows the YLN to add additional libraries. An LSTA grant will be pursued to add those libraries which desire YLN membership.

**Goal:** Pursue an LSTA grant to cover startup costs for libraries joining the YLN.

**Project Lead:** Corey Christians

### Progress:

- Attend the LSTA workshop. (1/16/13)
- Reach out to new potential members.
- Get a letter from potential members.
- Fill out the appropriate LSTA grant information.
- Receive grant for adding the new members.
- Add new libraries.
- Configure new libraries.
- Convert MUSD collections.

## Priority Four: Replace Blue Sockets for YCFLD libraries

Replace all existing networking controllers with a new network controller running over a virtual network. This will reduce network and support costs for the YCFLD libraries.

**Goal:** Simplify the network of the YCFLD libraries.

**Project Lead:** Jim Lowman

### Progress:

- Determine if the new solution will work in our networking environment.
- Purchase the new device
- Set up a test network
- Install Access Points at YCFLD libraries
- Remove each existing networking device

Note concerning prioritization: The priority of projects may shift as individual portions are completed.



## Priority Five: YLN Strategic Plan

While the YLN has been very good about technology planning, the overall vision and strategy of the YLN has been more elusive. The Executive Committee has been working on developing a vision, mission, and strategic plan.

**Goal:** Develop a strategic plan that will bring the YLN to the year 2020.

**Project Lead:** Corey Christians

### Progress:

- Develop a survey to send out to the membership.
- Use the results to make a list of discussion areas
- Start brainstorming about strategy/mission/vision
- Develop a final strategic plan
- Get approval of the plan

## Priority Six: SIS Integration

School and academic institutions have a student information system (SIS) that contains all the information about their students. Importing this information into Symphony will save time for library staff.

**Goal:** Automate the export/import of student data from academic and school institutions.

**Project Lead:** Chanel Wheeler

### Progress:

- Determine the data needs of the K-12 libraries
- Develop a plan to import student data
- Train K-12 library staff on the new plan
- Determine the needs of academic libraries
- Observe use of student IDs/library cards at academic library circulation desks
- Resolve card disparity between library types
- Design a viable SIS import automation solution
- Get academic libraries' feedback on the solution
- Work with academic IT departments for data format
- Create data mapping script
- Test data import
- Automate the process

## Priority Seven: OPAC Evaluation

The eLibrary problems that have been plaguing the Network for the last couple of years need to be resolved. An evaluation of Enterprise and VuFind2 needs to take place so we can eliminate eLibrary.

- Create a demonstration script
- Set up a demo date/time
- Create an evaluation form
- Compile evaluation results
- Determine which OPAC we will switch to

## Priority Eight: Separate Policies and Procedures

Currently policies and procedures are integrated in the circulation and cataloging manuals. The combination has led to some confusion regarding the purpose of the manuals.

**Goal:** Create two distinct documents that detail policies and procedures.

**Project Lead:** Corey Christians

### Progress:

- Create a joint subcommittee with representatives from circulation, cataloging, and public services.
- Have the committee determine what are policies and what are procedures
- Draft a policy document
- Create a final version of the policy document
- Get approval for the document from each user group and the network steering committee
- Have the circulation and cataloging committees edit their existing manuals so they policies are removed



## Priority Nine: VuFind Implementation

The new VuFind2 is built on a different framework than the previous VuFind. Chanel needs to learn about the new framework to be able to customize and configure our VuFind OPAC.

**Goal:** Have a working version of VuFind that can be compared to Enterprise with eRC.

- Fix holdings layout so it is closer to eLibrary
- Verify title/copy holds works
- Add AR search functionality
- Add RC search functionality
- Create YLN Skin
- Add new item functionality
- Add reviews, synopsis, etc.
- Add “times renewed” to checkout page
- Add “activate/suspend holds” functionality
- Add course reserves functionality
- Add “browse by library” to front page
- Add Dewey sorting to search results
- Fix due date format for renewed items
- Add “change expiration date” functionality
- Modify format type processing
- Fix VuFind mobile
- Have library staff test VuFind 2
- Move favorites, comments, and tags from VuFind 1
- Notify the public that there lists will not migrate
- Go live on VuFind 2

## Priority Ten: Implement SMS features into the ILS

Cell phone texting features need to be added to Symphony. This will allow library users to get messages regarding their library account via their mobile phone.

**Goal:** Implement SMS functionality in Symphony.

**Project Lead:** Corey Christians

### Progress:

- Purchase an SMS bundle from SirsiDynix
- Create documentation
- Have VER test the new feature
- Have PCL test the new feature
- Send out documentation to libraries (5/6/13)
- Enable SMS features in Symphony (5/7/2013)
- All YLN libraries can start testing (5/7/2013)
- Train staff on how to use the new feature (6/12/13)
- Allow public to start using (6/14/2013)
- Publicize the new feature (6/17/2013)
