Manager's Lowdown

The upgrade to the newest version of Web Services is complete. Web Services works in the background managing certain connections between some SirsiDynix products and Symphony. Some of the products we utilize with Web services is Enterprise, and Bookmyne. This upgrade opens up the possibility of implementing BlueCloud Cataloging. Chanel will start configuring BlueCloud Cataloging as soon as possible. Once it is configured she will start testing it and then start training on it. We are hoping this new product will be a great alternative to cataloging in WorkFlows.

SirsiDynix conducted some basic cataloging training in February for the YLN. This was the first training session in a package of training purchased with our BlueCloud Rewards through SirsiDynix. Several other training sessions will be scheduled throughout the the calendar year. If there is something specifically you would like to be trained in please email me the details.

Our newest member in the YLN is almost ready to start circulating items. Mingus Union High School recently completed their collection conversion so now all of their items are in the union catalog. Chanel, Cindy, Jim, and Lisa have been working hard to finish last minute configurations, conduct training sessions, and work out other logistical issues. If you see items coming from or going to MUHS don't be alarmed. They are going to Mingus Union High School in Cottonwood. Thanks to everyone that helped make their transition a success.

Barbara Kile and I have been conversing with Tech Logic over the last month about several issues with the most relevant issue being the cost of technical support. Recently Tech Logic sent out a letter to all of their customers announcing an across the board increase of 4%. This 4% increase is in violation of our contract with Tech Logic and does not apply to us. When you receive a maintenance bill from Tech Logic please be

sure to compare it with last year's bill.

Our contract with Tech Logic states the following:

"Cost increases for products and services may not increase by an annual percentage greater than the lesser of these two following options:


- A. Five percent (5%) per year.
- B. The increase in the Consumer Price Index for the Western Region of the United States for the most recent 12-month period."

I calculate the CPI for the Western Region of the United States at 1.3% over the last 12 months. If there is a maintenance increase great than 1.3% be sure to contact Barbara or me so we can get them to revise the bill.

Tech Logic has also stated they expect an update to their software to come out by April 3rd. I am highly skeptical the update will be ready by then so don't be surprised if there is a delay.

We are also in the planning stages for the transition of the YLN servers to be moved to the Yavapai County data center on Fair Street. Currently the transition is scheduled for June 16th or 17th. All YLN servers will be offline for the entire day of the transition.

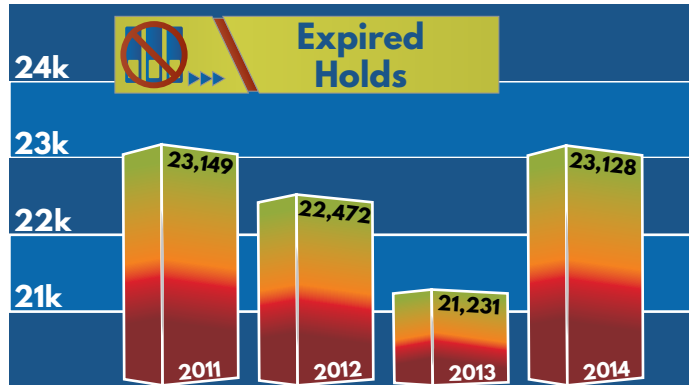
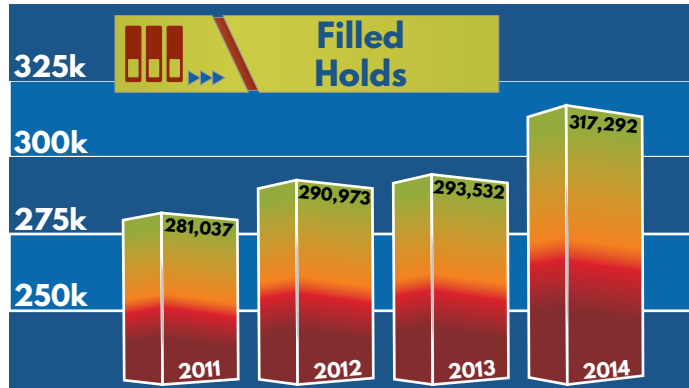

Prioritization

Priority One: Resolve Current Helpdesk Requests

A help desk request, or work order, is the submission of a problem that one encounters during the normal operation of a YLN service. Requests are generally submitted via e-mail to help@yln.info. If a request is submitted via telephone, then a YLN staff person will create the request for the submitter. Help desk requests will always be our highest priority because in some cases a member library employee cannot complete a work function until the issue is resolved.

Priority Two: Draft and RFP for a new Integrated Library System

The time is here to start looking into purchasing a new Integrated Library System (ILS). Stage one is sending out the RFP

Goal: Create a request for proposal for a new integrated library system.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Install a wiki that can be used to gather information about what we want in a new ILS
- Test the wiki to make sure it works
- Send instructions out on how to use it
- Start having meetings to determine what we want in a new ILS
- Compile the results and add them to the wiki
- Form an RFP committee
- Survey the current ILS market
- Start work on the RFP
- Create a draft RFP
- Send the RFP out to the membership for comment
- Create the final draft
- Seek steering committee approval
- Distribute to all interested vendors

Priority Three: Migrate vhosts from VMWare ESXi to Microsoft HyperV

Currently several servers are running virtually on a VMWare ESXi virtual host. Some of them include the YLN website, RPA, EZproxy, DNS, and many many more. The YLN will be switching to Microsoft HyperV in order to increase data redundancy and to increase support availability. The MIS Operations team also uses HyperV which will allow deep support with this product. This will require purchasing a new server, migrating current virtual servers and converting existing virtual hosts to HyperV.

- Determine if HyperV will work in our Linux/Windows environment
- Spec out a new server that can house all existing virtual servers as well as any future servers.
- Receive approval to purchase the new server
- Order new server
- Receive the new server
- Migrate existing ESXi virtual servers to HyperV
- Wipe ESXi servers and install HyperV
- Set up the new server to back up to the old servers

Priority Four: Install the BookMyne Mobile App

There has been repeated demand for a mobile application for the OPAC. SirsiDynix has a product called BookMyne that serves this purpose.

Goal: Install the BookMyne mobile app

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Determine if BC rewards can be applied
- Request a quote from SirsiDynix
- Get approval for the purchase
- Fill out implementation form
- Configure the software
- Install a test instance
- Find a library to run a beta test
- Configure for the remaining libraries
- Put into production

Note concerning prioritization: The priority of projects may shift as individual portions are completed.

Priority Five: YLN Strategic Plan

While the YLN has been very good about technology planning, the overall vision and strategy of the YLN has been more elusive. The Executive Committee has been working on developing a vision, mission, and strategic plan.

Goal: Develop a strategic plan that will bring the YLN to the year 2025.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Develop a survey to send out to the membership.
- Use the results to make a list of discussion areas
- Start brainstorming about strategy/mission/vision
- Develop a final strategic plan
- Get approval of the plan

Priority Six: Move Servers from PPL to County Admin Building

The YLN servers have been housed at PPL since Yavapai County took over administration of the YLN in 2011. The servers need to be moved to the County data center.

Goal: Transfer all YLN equipment from the Prescott Public Library to the County Administration building.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Ensure e-rate applies to the new line
- Get YCFLD BoD approval to purchase the line
- Work with Century Link to set a date to install an Internet line at Fair St.
- Make YLN members aware of the transfer date
- Let the media know we will be down that day
- Coordinate with facilities to move the equipment
- Coordinate with MIS Networking to reconfigure networking equipment
- Bring the systems back online

Priority Seven: Upgrade to Circ-IT NXT (RFID libraries only)

Our current version of Circ-IT will no longer be enhanced. Tech Logic is encouraging everyone to move to their new Circ-IT NXT platform

Goal: Switch from Circ-IT to Circ-IT NXT

Project Lead: Jim Lowman

Progress:

- Fill out the configuration form
- Create a virtual server for NXT
- Coordinate with TL to install the new software
- Configure the new interface
- Configure receipts
- Configure a beta site (YCFLD Central Office)
- Put into production for YCFLD
- Configure a public beta site (PVPL)
- Put into production for PVPL
- Put into production for PCL after beta test
- Configure and transfer remaining libraries

Priority Eight: OPAC Enhancements

The new OPAC has solved several problems that eLibrary had; however, problems still exist which need to be ironed out. The list of these issues is below.

Goal: Improve the catalog experience for library users.

Project Lead: Chanel Wheeler

Progress:

- Make it so the UPC retrieves cover art
- Make it so ICat1 displays item format
- Make it so second UPC shows cover art
- Make it so the book river shows cover art
- Determine if online registration is feasible
- Fix reserve item searching for YCV
- Add icons for ICat1s that don't have them
- Add (item) details button to search results
- Add the ability to add local cover art
- Always have location listings expand

Prioritization

Priority Nine: Implement Blue Cloud Cataloging

Blue Cloud Cataloging will allow library staff to access Symphony cataloging from a web browser. The new product should have significant user interface improvements above the cataloging section in Work Flows.

Goal: Fully implement Blue Cloud Cataloging (BCC)

Project Lead: Chanel Wheeler

- Upgrade Web Services so we can use BCC
- Configure Web Services for the new service
- Test BCC to see how it works
- Create documentation
- Activate it for a test library to see how it works in a production environment
- Conduct a training session for all YLN users
- Activate it for the remaining libraries

Priority Ten: Add MUHS

Mingus Union High School is the latest member of the YLN. Their migration is funded by an LSTA grant.

Goal: Add MUHS as a full member of the YLN.

- Receive the funds from the LSTA grant
- Order the agency from SirsiDynix
- Add agency parameters and rules in Symphony
- Begin cataloging the collection
- Add students
- Train MUHS staff
- Begin circulating
