Manager's Lowdown

Greetings YLN Stakeholders,

Let me introduce myself. My name is Judy Poe, and I am your new Network Manager. Originally from central Pennsylvania, I come to YLN by way of the small town of Bayfield, Colorado. Sitting at approximately 7000 feet above sea level, Bayfield is in the south San Juan Mountains, halfway between Durango and Pagosa Springs. Yes, that area gets a lot of snow, and yes, I am looking forward to warmer and milder Prescott winters!

Over the past 30 years, I have had a variety of careers, but most recently, I've worked in libraries in North Carolina and Colorado. I hold a BS in Information & Library Services from the University of Maine, as well as an MLIS from San Jose State University. I began working in Bayfield's Pine River Library in 2007 as a Library Tech, and for the next 9 years, I was involved in all aspects of library work, including circulation and programming, acquisitions and cataloging, project management and community liaison work, as well as management. I finished my time at PRL as Assistant Director. In that time, I had many interesting and challenging experiences, from construction of a library addition and a 17000 square-foot community garden to dropping the DDS and creating our own BISAC-inspired, word-based classification system, to completing two successful ILS migrations in less than a month, and being named Library Journal's 2014 Best Small Library in America. In addition, I was on the executive committee of the groundbreaking 2012 Risk & Reward (R-Squared) Conference in Telluride, Colorado. (I do hope that some of you were able to attend!) It has been an exciting, sometimes chaotic, and wild ride. I'm happy to say I survived it all and am eager to sign up for more.

I began work last week and was fortunate to start in time to attend the July 27th Steering Committee meeting in Sedona--on just my second day. At that meeting, the committee approved the purchase of the AMH, and agreed to partner with DPLA to pilot a new service that could eventually allow us to have one platform through which all our e-materials can be accessed.

In addition, Corey announced that he will be doubling YFL's budget for Zinio materials, and has asked that everyone submit their input as to which titles should be

added. Corey also spoke about his interest in establishing a Network-wide master contract for library materials, in order to secure better pricing for all. I'll be contacting everyone about your current book jobbers and Corey will be hiring a consultant to write an RFP to take us through the process of setting up a contract.

As for the new Cataloger position, YCFLD received over 20 applications, which we have narrowed down to five. We will start interviewing in two weeks.

On a personal note, I'm very grateful to the Executive Committee for their vote of confidence in hiring me. Thank you in advance for your understanding and patience as I get up to speed with everything the Network is doing. (Unfortunately, I'll be out of the office taking care of some prior commitments for the next week and a half, but will be back in the new Network offices by August 16th and will be ready to hit the ground running.) I relish the opportunity to work with all the wonderful people in YLN's 43 member libraries and am looking forward to meeting and visiting each and every one of you over the next few months. I'd like to discuss your ideas and goals for the Network, and share a few of my own. This is a very progressive consortium!

Priority One: Resolve Current Helpdesk Requests

Priority Two: Draft an RFP for an RFID and AMH System

The time is here to start looking into the possibility of purchasing a new Radio-Frequency Identification (RFID) and/or Automated Materials Handling (AMH) system. Stage one is drafting the RFP.

Goal: Create a request for proposal for an RFID/AMH system.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Explore RFID RFP options
- Install a wiki that can be used to gather information about what we want in an RFID System
- Test the wiki to make sure it works
- Form an RFP committee
- Survey the current RFID market
- Have an initial RFP meeting
- Update the wiki with the results
- Start work on the RFP
- Create a draft RFP
- Send the RFP out to the membership for comment
- Create the final draft
- Seek steering committee approval

Priority Three: YLN Strategic Plan

While the YLN has been very good about technology planning, the overall vision and strategy of the YLN has been more elusive. The Executive Committee has been working on developing a vision, mission, and strategic plan.

Goal: Develop a strategic plan that will bring the YLN to the year 2025.

Priority Four: Implement BC Visibility

BlueCloud Visibility is a new product by SirsiDynix which converts our online catalog to a linked data model. This will make our records visible in search engines such as Google.

Goal: Implement BC Visibility

Project Lead: Chanel Wheeler

Progress:

- Receive a quote from SirsiDynix
- Get approval for the purchase
- Receive an implementation plan from SD
- Offload our bibliographic database to SD to be processed.
- Test the implementation.
- Go Live
- Advertise the new service

Note concerning prioritization: The priority of projects may shift as individual portions are completed.

Priority Five: Implement Blue Cloud Cataloging

Blue Cloud Cataloging will allow library staff to access Symphony cataloging from a web browser. The new product should have significant user interface improvements above the cataloging section in WorkFlows.

Goal: Fully implement Blue Cloud Cataloging (BCC)

- Test BCC to see how it works
- Create documentation
- Activate it for a test library to see how it works in a production environment
