LIBRARY NETWORK MANAGER'S LOWDOWN

Regretfully the data corruption ate up a considerable amount of time. With the exception of some OPAC statistical data we have completely recovered from the data corruption. I have drafted a letter to be sent to SirsiDynix summarizing the successes and failures of the effort to clean up the bad data. The letter will be signed by the Executive Committee on behalf of the entire YLN. I will make the letter available to the entire YLN once it has been approved and signed.

Lisa Griest has left her position as Director of Yavapai College Libraries. She has been a great visionary for Yavapai College and for the YLN. She will be missed at our regular meetings. Chris Abbate has been promoted to the new Director of Yavapai College Libraries. Chris has been a significant presence for Yavapai College and I am pleased we have her considerable expertise on the Management Committee.

YLN staff is moving forward and making some good progress on the transfer of student data from various K-12 student information systems to the Symphony system. Chanel has been working tirelessly to make sure all the data is going to be translated properly and that the needs of the K-12 libraries will be met. The technical contacts at the school districts have been a great help. This next month should see some significant progress for this project.

The proposal to have the Yavapai County Free Library District pay for the operation of the Network appears to be more and more likely. If this proposal is viable this will mean significant improvements in service for the YLN as well as reduced member fees. Under the proposal a fixed \$175,000 will be billed out to members annually with no other assessments. This fixed amount will be placed into savings and will accumulate over the years. This will significantly increase our purchasing capabilities as well as adding a needed element of predictability to the annual membership assessments. If successful the YLN budget will be around \$406,000 in FY13 and the members will be billed a total of \$175,000 for capital reserve.

CURRENT STATUS:

The issues in regards to billing have been resolved. I was able to work through the process of adding our missing bibliographic and item records. The libraries that wanted batch updates had their data uploaded to OCLC on 1/17/2012. This filled in the gap between January, 2011 reclamation project and now. This is the first part in the process. While determining how best to address the deletion portion, I discovered some oddness on how Symphony handles deletions with OCLC. Apparently I have to delete all the DISCARD items BEFORE I upload the report to OCLC. Symphony then looks through the transactions logs and makes a report of the deleted items to submit to OCLC. This process is much different than I originally thought it would be. I will have to remove DISCARD items before uploading the deletions to OCLC.



PRIORITY: VUFIND IMPLEMENTATION**PROGRESS: ONGOING****CURRENT STATUS:**

Chanel has taken some time to start digging into the VuFind software. The first part she is examining is the work Tom has done dealing with extracting and uploading the data from Symphony. She has found some issues that she is addressing. We will come up with a development and implementation plan in February. Now that the eLibrary issues appear to be behind us for the time being we can start looking more into VuFind.

PRIORITY: CREATE A NEW PORTAL AND TRANSFER PERTINENT EXISTING INFORMATION**PROGRESS: EXPLORATION****UPGRADE DATE: JUNE 2012****CURRENT STATUS:**

We are currently exploring alternatives to Joomla for the YLN intranet. While Joomla has worked well for the last five years we would like a software package that allows users to easily upload files. This should make the posting of the minutes much more expeditious. Libraries could also easily post documentation that they have written so other libraries can benefit. Different levels of permissions would also be useful.

Symphony, the Symphony test server, Telemessage, Director's Station, Staffweb and the Networking equipment have all been moved. Five servers remain. A date to complete the move has not been set.

PROGRESS: WORKING ON STUDENT RECORD STANDARDIZATION

CURRENT STATUS:

YLN staff had a meeting with all the K-12 libraries to discuss the impact of automatically loading student data. We are attempting to come up with a universal format for student record data entry into Symphony. This will greatly simplify the data mapping process. Our initial run at standardization had some flaws which are currently being looked at. Chanel has also successfully tested a fake student data load using fabricated data on the test server and it worked. The next step will be to get a sample data dump and to create a script to match the data to equivalent fields on the Symphony server.
