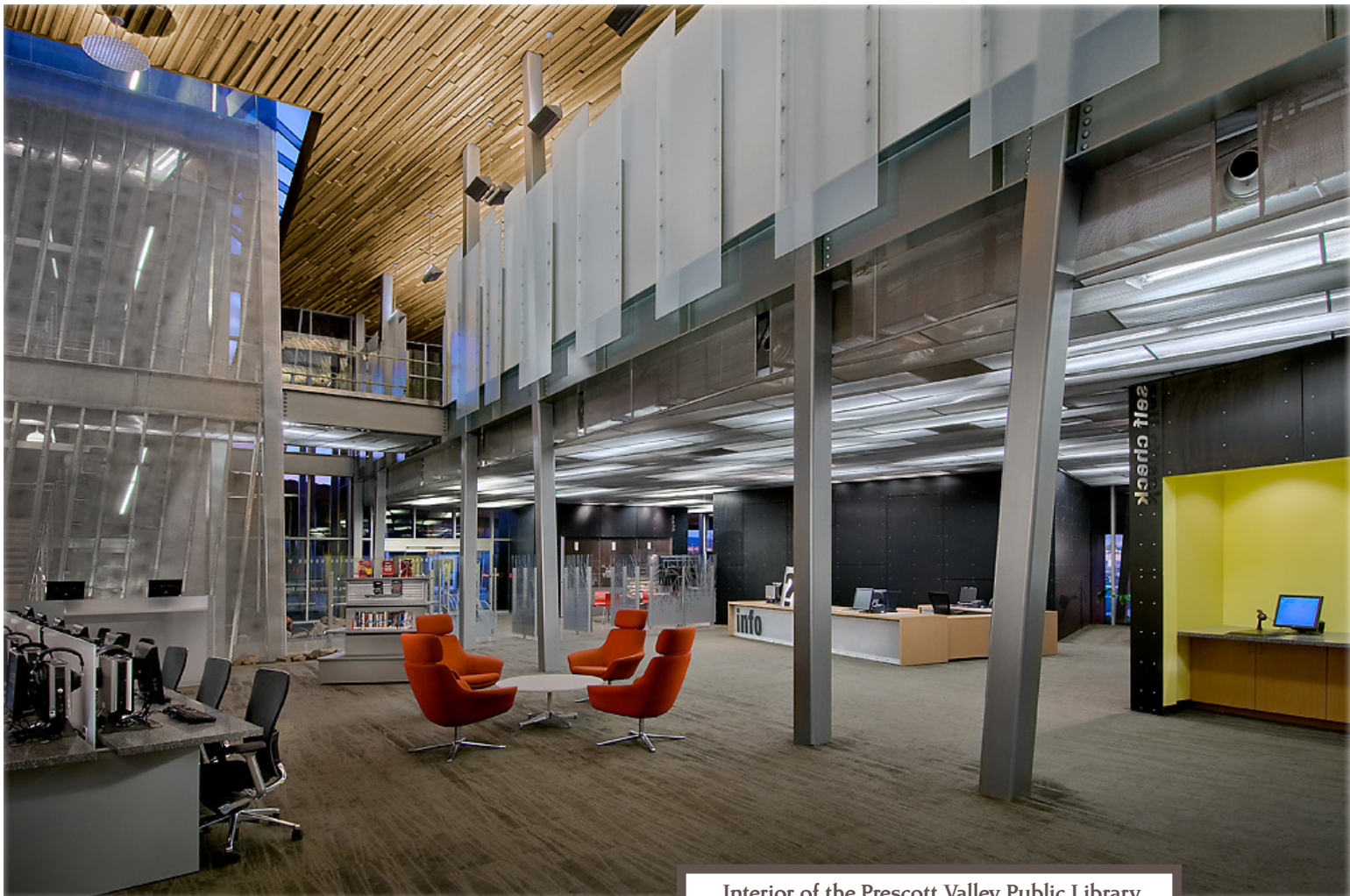

Library Network Manager's Lowdown

The first month of 2013 saw the completion of several long-term projects that we at the YLN have been working on. The first group of these were several policies that were put into effect at the last management meeting. They are available on the portal (Intranet → Administration → Policies).

The first of these policies is the data retention policy. It was implemented hastily to make sure the YLN is in compliance with Arizona statute with regards to data retention. The formal policy was approved this month. The next policy concerns patron privacy and the retention of circulation history. Lastly, a policy was adopted concerning the ethics of modifying a patron's record. My hope is that these policies will give YLN members a clear view of what is expected of them in these areas. Also, a committee is being formed that will deal with policy concerning circulation and cataloging as well.

Another completed project was the final approval of the YLN Technology Plan. The plan was written for the next five years and addresses several technical areas including the potential purchase of a new Integrated Library System and full implementation and integration of the Student Information System for the academics.

A key decision was also made at the last management committee meeting to switch from a Universal Card system (a single-card system) to a three-card system. Each library type (academic, K-12, and public) will have their own set of patrons. They will not be separated out in the patron database and every member library will still be able to see each patron. The real difference is the potential now exists for a single patron to have three different library cards. This change was necessary to fully implement the Student Information System (SIS) project.

The FY2012-2013 billing amounts were prepared and made public at the last Management Committee meeting as well. If you did not attend the meeting and would like to know what you are going to be billed before the letter is sent please let me know. Each library's governing authority will be sent their bill in March. All bills will be paid to the Yavapai County Free Library District.

Another look at the special collections is going to take place. Member libraries have taken stewardship of each special collection. Some members have taken responsibility for several special collections and are having difficulty keeping up. The Prescott College Library has taken over stewardship of the ECOSA Institute special collection. The YCFLD is taking a look at the Prescott Veteran's Administration Library and the court library to see if they can take over stewardship of these special collections. Talks have commenced with the court library.

Barbara Kile and I attended the ALA Midwinter conference. We spent most of our time meeting with ILS vendors to take a look at the current state of the marketplace. The good news is if we decide to replace Symphony there are many viable alternatives.

Priority One: Resolve Current Helpdesk Requests

A help desk request, or work order, is a problem that one encounters during normal operation if a YLN service. Requests are generally submitted via e-mail to help@yln.info. If a request is submitted via telephone than a YLN staff person will create the request for the submitter. Help desk requests will always be our highest priority because in some cases a member library employee cannot complete a work function until the issue is resolved.

- Total unresolved requests opened in January: 4**
- Total requests still open: 53**

Priority Two: Expand Telemessage Access

The Telemessage (Itiva) system notifies library users via the telephone if they have an overdue item or an available hold. Library users can also call in an renew items, find out their bills, or just see what they have out. Currently this service is only available for PPL and PVPL.

Goal: Upgrade and expand the Telemessage service to include all public libraries within the local calling area in Cottonwood and Prescott that desire the service.

Progress:

- Upgrade server to Windows 2008 (1/30/13)
- Upgrade Telemessage to the latest version (1/30/13)
- Determine county telephone accessibility
- Transfer phone service to the county system
- Add additional libraries
- Advertise new service

Priority Three: Add Additional Libraries

SirsiDynix has significantly reduced the cost of adding a library. The reduction in cost allows the YLN to add additional libraries. An LSTA grant will be pursued to add those libraries which desire YLN membership.

Goal: Pursue an LSTA grant to cover startup costs for libraries joining the YLN.

- Attend the LSTA workshop. (1/16/13)
- Reach out to new potential members.
- Get a letter from potential members.
- Fill out the appropriate LSTA grant information.
- Get for adding the new members.
- Configure and add new libraries..

Priority Four: Vufind Implementation

Priority Five: YLN Strategic Plan

While the YLN has been very good about technology planning the overall vision and strategy of the YLN has been more elusive. The Executive Committee has been working on developing a vision, mission, and strategic plan.

Goal: Develop a strategic plan that will bring the YLN to the year 2020.

Progress:

- Develop a survey to send out to the membership.
- Use the results to make a list of discussion areas
- Start brainstorming about strategy/mission/vision
- Develop a final strategic plan
- Get approval of the plan

Priority Six: SIS Integration

School and academic institutions have a student information system (SIS) that contains all the information about their students. Importing this information into Symphony will save time for library staff.

Goal: Automate the export/import of student data from academic and school institutions.

Project Lead: Chanel Wheeler

Progress:

- Determine the data needs of the K-12 libraries
- Develop a plan to import student data
- Train K-12 library staff on the new plan
- Determine the needs of academic libraries
- Get approval of three-card system
- Observe use of student IDs/library cards at academic library circulation desks
- Design a viable SIS import automation solution
- Get academic libraries' feedback on the solution
- Work with academic IT departments for data format
- Create data mapping script
- Test data import
- Automate the process

Priority Seven: Member Billing

The appropriate statistics have to be applied to the formula to determine what each member will pay. All payments will be applied to our reserve. The bill should be sent by March 15th.

Goal: Determine what each library should pay and draft a letter for billing.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Compile the annual statistics
- Plug the appropriate statistics into the formula
- Notify Network libraries what their bill will be
- Draft a letter to go with the bill
- Send out the bill (YCFLD sends the bill)

Priority Eight: Separate Policies and Procedures

Currently policies and procedures are integrated in the circulation and cataloging manuals. The combination has led to some confusion regarding the purpose of the manuals.

Goal: Create two distinct documents that detail policies and procedures.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Create a joint subcommittee with representatives from circulation, cataloging, and public services.
- Have the committee determine what are policies and what are procedures
- Draft two different documents.
- Get approval from each user group and the network steering committee



Priority Ten: Implement SMS features into the ILS

Cell phone texting features need to be added to Symphony. This will allow library users to get messages regarding the library account to their mobile phone.

Goal: Implement SMS functionality in Symphony.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Purchase an SMS bundle from SirsiDynix
- Enable SMS features in Symphony
- Create documentation
- Train staff on how to use the new feature
- Publicize the new feature

Priority Eleven: Replace Blue Sockets for YCFLD libraries

Replace all existing networking controllers with a new network controller running over a virtual network. This will reduce network and support costs for the YCFLD libraries.

Goal: Simplify the network of the YCFLD libraries.

Project Lead: Jim Lowman

Progress:

- Determine if the new solution will work in our networking environment.
- Purchase the new device
- Set up a test network
- Remove each existing networking device

Completed Projects

- Created the YLN data retention, privacy, and ethics policy
- Took an initial look at ILS vendors
- Created the YLN Technology Plan
- Upgraded Telemessage software to the latest version
