Library Network Manager's Lowdown

I have good news! I was able to negotiate paying nothing for Bookmyne+ with SirsiDynix. Bookmyne+ is an app that allows library users to use the online catalog from an iOS device (such as the iPhone). We used a combination of our Blue Cloud Rewards and some remaining credit to purchase the software.

The best part is that not only will this cost us nothing in the present it will continue to cost us nothing in the future. As long as we continue to use Bookmyne+ our Bluecloud Rewards will continue to be used year after year.

I would like to thank Martha Baden and Roger Saft at PPL for their extensive help with the e-materials vendor search. They have called libraries, asked questions, compiled results and were sure to keep YLN involved as they investigated. I am very grateful for all of their efforts. The results of that research have been very interesting. Several conclusions were made and some of them are as follows:

- 1) Only Overdrive supports the Kindle format. While the new Kindle Fire devices can download an app that will play non-Kindle e-books, the older Kindle devices cannot. Currently, 47% of the overall Overdrive eBook circulation is to library users utilizing the Kindle format.
- 2) Overdrive is the only vendor to allow library users to read their books in the browser. Other vendors have plans for this but it has not happened yet.
- 3) Many libraries that have 3M, Baker and Taylor, and/or Recorded Books also have Overdrive. At this point they seemed unable to support the idea of using any of the aforementioned vendors as a replacement for Overdrive.

4) The materials included with the Recorded Books platform fee appeared to be material that library users would be unlikely to checkout. The titles offered appear to not be popular or high interest titles. If that is true, then the YLN would just end up paying a larger amount for a platform fee than with Overdrive.

5) Vendors were unable or unwilling to provide examples of multitype consortia that were currently using their platform. This could simply be a result of the "newness" of their platforms but it is true nonetheless.

6) Uncertainty still exists around the ability for the YLN to transfer its Overdrive collection to a competing vendor. While we do know some items will not transfer (depending on licensing) we do not know for sure that the other items will transfer.

7) A possibility exists that the State Library may purchase a contract with B&T, 3M, or RB statewide. If this plan comes to fruition we could use that service as a supplement to Overdrive.

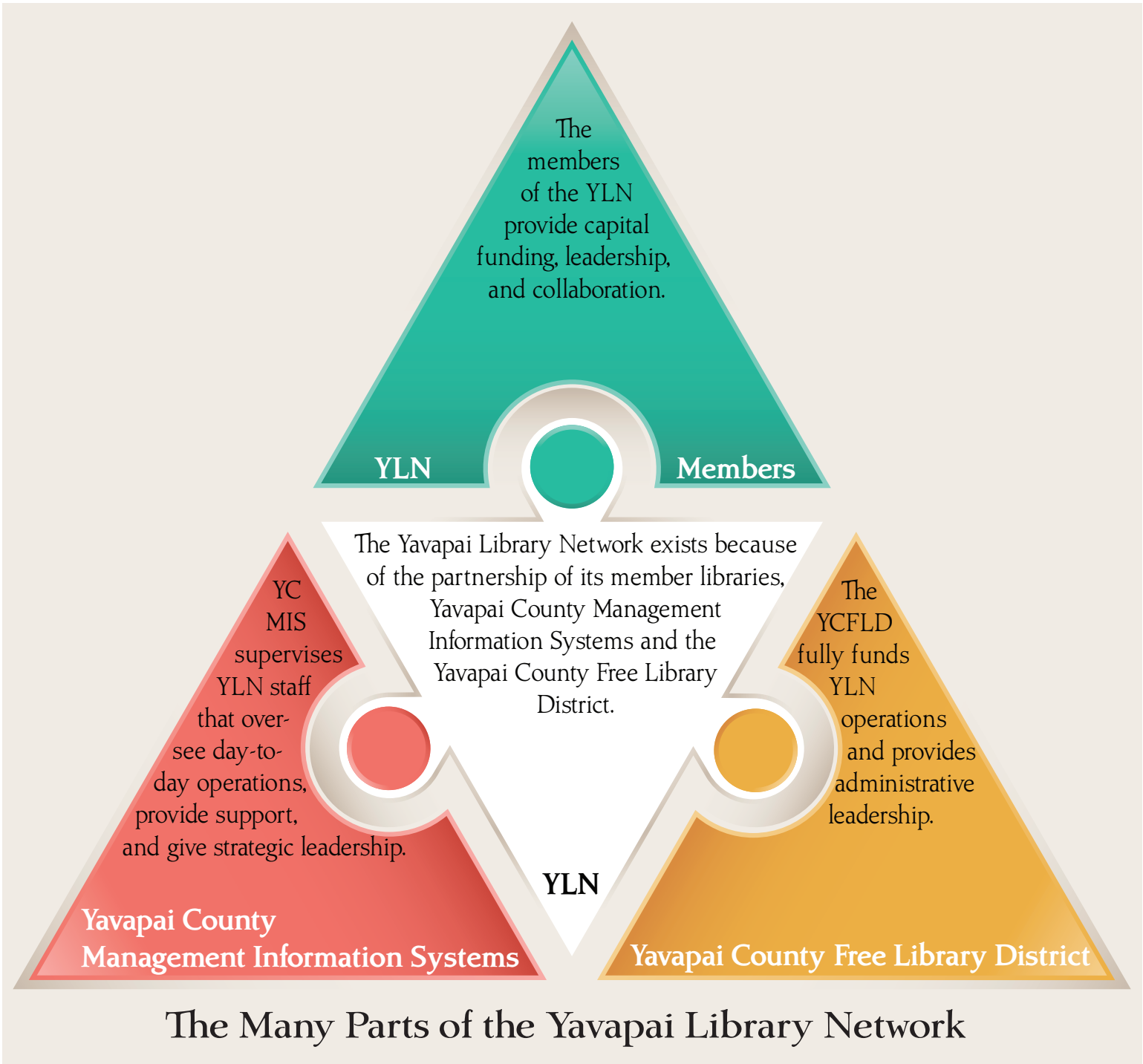

Priority One: Resolve Current Helpdesk Requests

A help desk request, or work order, is the submission of a problem that one encounters during the normal operation of a YLN service. Requests are generally submitted via e-mail to help@yln.info. If a request is submitted via telephone, then a YLN staff person will create the request for the submitter. Help desk requests will always be our highest priority because in some cases a member library employee cannot complete a work function until the issue is resolved.

Priority Two: Implement a Learning Management System (LMS)

Moodle has been selected for our LMS. The Learning Management System is necessary to track individual training progress, provide training materials, create assessment tools, and supplement in-person training.

Goal: Install, configure, test and go live with the Moodle Learning Management System.

Project Lead: Unassigned

Progress:

- Install the virtual machine using the Linux OS
- Create a new hostname in DNS
- Install the Moodle software
- Customize Moodle to better fit YLN needs
- Begin adding content to the system
- Add users or determine if existing user databases can be utilized to interface with Moodle
- Have a basic amount of content in the LMS
- Give the YLN membership access to the new LMS

Priority Three: Migrate vhosts from VMWare ESXi to Microsoft HyperV

Currently several servers are running virtually on a VMWare ESXi virtual host. Some of them include the YLN website, RPA, EZproxy, DNS, and many many more. The YLN will be switching to Microsoft HyperV in order to increase data redundancy and to increase support availability. The MIS Operations team also uses HyperV which will allow deep support with this product. This will require purchasing a new server, migrating current virtual servers and converting existing virtual hosts to HyperV.

- Determine if HyperV will work in our Linux/Windows environment
- Spec out a new server that can house all existing virtual servers as well as any future servers.
- Receive approval to purchase the new server
- Order new server
- Receive the new server
- Migrate existing ESXi virtual servers to HyperV
- Wipe ESXi servers and install HyperV
- Set up the new server to back up to the old servers

Priority Four: Install the BookMyne Mobile App

There has been repeated demand for a mobile application for the OPAC. SirsiDynix has a product called BookMyne that serves this purpose.

Goal: Install the BookMyne mobile app

Project Lead: Chanel Wheeler

Progress:

- Determine if BC rewards can be applied
- Request a quote from SirsiDynix
- Get approval for the purchase
- Fill out implementation form
- Configure the software
- Install a test instance
- Find a library to run a beta test
- Configure for the remaining libraries
- Put into production

Note concerning prioritization: The priority of projects may shift as individual portions are completed.



Priority Five: YLN Strategic Plan

While the YLN has been very good about technology planning, the overall vision and strategy of the YLN has been more elusive. The Executive Committee has been working on developing a vision, mission, and strategic plan.

Goal: Develop a strategic plan that will bring the YLN to the year 2025.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Develop a survey to send out to the membership.
- Use the results to make a list of discussion areas
- Start brainstorming about strategy/mission/vision
- Develop a final strategic plan
- Get approval of the plan

Priority Six: Move Servers from PPL to County Admin Building

The YLN servers have been housed at PPL since Yavapai County took over administration of the YLN in 2011. The servers need to be moved to the County data center.

Goal: Transfer all YLN equipment from the Prescott Public Library to the County Administration building.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Ensure e-rate applies to the new line
- Get YCFLD BoD approval to purchase the line
- Work with Century Link to set a date to install an Internet line at Fair St.
- Make YLN members aware of the transfer date
- Let the media know we will be down that day
- Coordinate with facilities to move the equipment
- Coordinate with MIS Networking to reconfigure networking equipment
- Bring the systems back online

Priority Seven: Potential Overdrive Replacement

Overdrive has refused to modify our contract to accomodate all of our library types, This has forced us to start looking for alternatives to the Overdrive service.

Goal: Determine if there is a superior alternative to Overdrive. If there is see what it will take to switch to it.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Determine if Overdrive is willing to modify our existing contract
- Contact vendors to see if they will allow all members of the YLN to participate.
- Draft a questionnaire to send to potential vendors
- Have demonstrations
- Select a new e-content vendor
- Notify the public of the change
- Migrate twelve months after new contract

Priority Eight: OPAC Enhancements

The new OPAC has solved several problems that eLibrary had; however, problems still exist which need to be ironed out. The list of these issues is below.

Goal: Improve the catalog experience for library users.

Project Lead: Chanel Wheeler

Progress:

- Make it so the UPC retrieves cover art
- Make it so ICat1 displays item format
- Remove GMD from the catalog
- Make it so second UPC shows cover art
- Make it so the book river shows cover art
- Determine if online registration is feasible
- Fix reserve item searching for YCV
- Add icons for ICat1s that don't have them
- Add (item) details button to search results
- Add the ability to add local cover art
- Always have location listings expand



Priority Nine: Value of Services for YLN

The YLN annual report was the first step in making the decision makers for our governing authorities aware of all the YLN does for them. The second step is demonstrating the incredible value of the YLN. The YLN, in conjunction with the YCFLD, will create a comprehensive Return on Investment (ROI) study to show how valuable the YLN is to our members. It will be submitted with the next annual report. Work will start on it now.

Goal: Determine the value of some or all library services for Yavapai County

- Present proposal to Management Committee
- Sign contract
- Have kickoff meeting
- Gather statistics
- Analyze compiled results from BERK
- Approve final study

Priority Ten: Add MUHS

Mingus Union High School is the latest member of the YLN. Their migration is funded by an LSTA grant.

Goal: Add MUHS as a full member of the YLN.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Pursue an LSTA grant
- Have initial profiling session with MUHS staff
- Receive the funds from the LSTA grant
- Order the agency from SirsiDynix
- Add agency parameters and rules in Symphony
- Begin cataloging the collection
- Add students
- Train MUHS staff
- Begin circulating

- Install PURL server
- Complete the Annual Report
- New Helpdesk Ticketing System
- Replace Blue Sockets in YCFLD Libraries

Cancelled/Postponed Projects CY14
