Monthly Report

Manager's Lowdown

I have talked in the past about how TechLogic told the YLN that we had a 4% increase in our annual maintenance fees. This is simply not the case. The amount they can increase the fees for any of our members on an annual basis is pegged to the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the Western United States for the last twelve months. The value for the CPI for the Western United States increased by 1% over the last twelve months. Tech Logic attempted to increase the maintenance of one YLN library by 4% even after the conversation Barbara and I conducted with them about how such an increase goes against our contract. Please be on the look out for increases in your maintenance above 1%.

I have also advised many libraries to stop paying maintenance on RFID antennas that were purchased at a cost ranging from \$1350 to \$1800. The newer antennas only cost around \$900. Currently Tech Logic is charging around \$300 annually for maintenance of the older antennas. It would be cheaper to simply replace 1/3 of your antennas each year and keep your old ones in reserve. If you would like more information on this please let me know.

The initial data gathering for the RFP process has almost concluded. If you would like to see a list of the features the RFP committee decided on you can take a look at all of them on the YLN Wiki. I have made appointments with several vendors at ALA to take a preliminary look at their ILS offerings. So far me and several other YLN representatives will see Innovative Interfaces Polaris, Innovative Interfaces Sierra, Evergreen supported by Equinox, Ex Libris Primo, Axiell Adlib, TLC Library Solution or CARL X,

Autographics Verso, and SirsiDynix Symphony. The main purpose of these mini-demonstrations is to make sure we are asking for the correct features on the RFP. It will also help us get a preliminary look at which products will most likely suit our needs. I will create a report summarizing our findings.

Chanel has been working hard on cleaning up the data in Symphony over the last several months. Her focus is now directed at cleaning up birthdates. Some libraries have done a poor job of entering in birthdates. Birthdates are important for several reasons:

- 1) The IMLS requires statistical information on the age of people using the library. This is important for them because it tracks overall trends in library use. This summation of age is required on the annual state data report. Birthdate is a mechanism used to find the age of a library user. Without it good statistical information cannot be provided.
- 2) According to YLN policies a patron record must contain the date of birth (Section 4.03.c.iii).
- 3) Tracking birthdates is also a good way to help the leaders of the library understand library usage. If there is a drop in a certain age group, library staff could start to see flaws in their community outreach program.

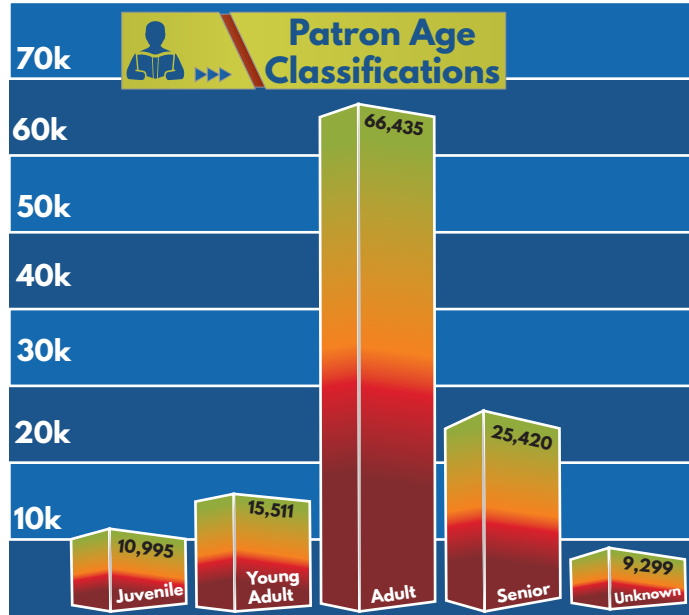
If your library has been lax in entering in birthdates please make an effort to ramp up birthdate data collection.

Prioritization

Priority One: Resolve Current Helpdesk Requests

A help desk request, or work order, is the submission of a problem that one encounters during the normal operation of a YLN service. Requests are generally submitted via e-mail to help@yln.info. If a request is submitted via telephone, then a YLN staff person will create the request for the submitter. Help desk requests will always be our highest priority because in some cases a member library employee cannot complete a work function until the issue is resolved.

Priority Two: Draft and RFP for a new Integrated Library System

The time is here to start looking into purchasing a new Integrated Library System (ILS). Stage one is sending out the RFP.

Goal: Create a request for proposal for a new integrated library system.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Install a wiki that can be used to gather information about what we want in a new ILS
- Test the wiki to make sure it works
- Send instructions out on how to use it
- Start having meetings to determine what we want in a new ILS
- Compile the results and add them to the wiki
- Form an RFP committee
- Survey the current ILS market
- Start work on the RFP
- Create a draft RFP
- Send the RFP out to the membership for comment
- Create the final draft
- Seek steering committee approval
- Distribute to all interested vendors

Priority Three: Migrate vhosts from VMWare ESXi to Microsoft HyperV

Currently several servers are running virtually on a VMWare ESXi virtual host. Some of them include the YLN website, RPA, EZproxy, DNS, and many many more. The YLN will be switching to Microsoft HyperV in order to increase data redundancy and to increase support availability. The MIS Operations team also uses HyperV which will allow deep support with this product. This will require purchasing a new server, migrating current virtual servers and converting existing virtual hosts to HyperV.

- Determine if HyperV will work in our Linux/Windows environment
- Spec out a new server that can house all existing virtual servers as well as any future servers.
- Receive approval to purchase the new server
- Order new server
- Receive the new server
- Migrate existing ESXi virtual servers to HyperV
- Wipe ESXi servers and install HyperV
- Set up the new server to back up to the old servers

Priority Four: Install the BookMyne Mobile App

There has been repeated demand for a mobile application for the OPAC. SirsiDynix has a product called BookMyne that serves this purpose.

Goal: Install the BookMyne mobile app

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Determine if BC rewards can be applied
- Request a quote from SirsiDynix
- Get approval for the purchase
- Fill out implementation form
- Configure the software
- Install a test instance
- Find a library to run a beta test
- Configure for the remaining libraries
- Put into production

Note concerning prioritization: The priority of projects may shift as individual portions are completed.

Prioritization

Priority Five: YLN Strategic Plan

While the YLN has been very good about technology planning, the overall vision and strategy of the YLN has been more elusive. The Executive Committee has been working on developing a vision, mission, and strategic plan.

Goal: Develop a strategic plan that will bring the YLN to the year 2025.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Create a way to implement the plan
- Get approval for the updated plan
- Change the bylaws if necessary
- Distribute the new plan

Priority Six: Move Servers from PPL to County Admin Building

The YLN servers have been housed at PPL since Yavapai County took over administration of the YLN in 2011. The servers need to be moved to the County data center.

Goal: Transfer all YLN equipment from the Prescott Public Library to the County Administration building.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Ensure e-rate applies to the new line
- Get YCFLD BoD approval to purchase the line
- Work with Century Link to set a date to install an Internet line at Fair St.
- Make YLN members aware of the transfer date
- Let the media know we will be down that day
- Coordinate with facilities to move the equipment
- Coordinate with MIS Networking to reconfigure networking equipment
- Transfer equipment from PPL to Fair Street
- Bring the systems back online
- Verify equipment is still working

Priority Seven: SirsiDynix Supported Servers End-of-Life

After a certain amount of time vendors will no longer support hardware because it is considered outmoded. In other words parts become hard to find because they are no longer manufactured. Our servers will have this problem as of May 31st, 2016.

Goal: Have a solution in place to deal with outmoded hardware.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Determine differing solution to the problem considering we may be on a new ILS in two years.
- Present the solutions to the Executive Committee
- Present the solutions to the Steering Committee
- Analyze which option is superior based on cost and stability
- Purchase any equipment that is required
- Migrate data and go into production

Priority Eight: SirsiDynix Maintenance Bill

One of the annual events I have to complete is to make sure our SirsiDynix maintenance bill is accurate and to assist in getting it paid.

Goal: Make sure the SirsiDynix annual maintenance bill accurate and that it gets paid.

Project Lead: Corey Christians

Progress:

- Receive a list of all items under maintenance from SirsiDynix
- Verify the items there are appropriate
- Verify the amounts being charged have not exceeded the amount agreed to in the contract
- Receive an updated list from SirsiDynix with all of my changes incorporated into it
- Verify my changes have been incorporated
- Have an invoice sent to YCFLD
- YCFLD Board approves payment

Prioritization

Priority Nine: Implement Blue Cloud Cataloging

Blue Cloud Cataloging will allow library staff to access Symphony cataloging from a web browser. The new product should have significant user interface improvements above the cataloging section in Work Flows.

Goal: Fully implement Blue Cloud Cataloging (BCC)

Project Lead: Chanel Wheeler

- Upgrade Web Services so we can use BCC
- Configure Web Services for the new service
- Test BCC to see how it works
- Create documentation
- Activate it for a test library to see how it works in a production environment
- Conduct a training session for all YLN users
- Activate it for the remaining libraries

Priority Ten: Upgrade RPA

RPA is using an old version of Windows which will be no longer supported very soon. The current version of RPA is not supported to work on a newer version of Windows. Our RPA has also not received an update from SirsiDynix since we migrated to Symphony five years ago. SirsiDynix has committed to updating the product.

Goal: Get the new version of RPA working

Project Leads: Jim Lowman and Chanel Wheeler

- Obtain a new Windows server license
- Install a new virtual server for RPA
- Sign the NDA with SD so we can install RPA
- Have SD install the new version of RPA
- Test RPA to make sure it still works
- Add all the existing authentication resources
- Go Live with the new RPA
- Update any web links if necessary
