## Manager's Lowdown

Greetings All,

Here are your February updates!

I have completed writing the YLN Cataloging Services Procedures and shared them via email this month. They have also been reviewed and approved by the Cataloging User Group and the Executive Committee. These procedures are a roadmap for how the YLN Cataloger will accept and catalog items from Network members. If you have any further input, please let me know.

Related to that, we'll be posting the Cataloging position again next week. Once hired, our cataloger will be able to hit the ground running (or the keyboard typing?) and start accepting member materials for cataloging. Hopefully, this will allow you to clear your backlogs of original cataloging, and get some help with additional materials as needed.

In addition, I'm continuing to work on the Strategic Plan. Soon, I'll be asking for some input from Network libraries and will incorporate this data into the new plan. More on that to come.

We are continuing to work toward securing our catalog with an SSL certificate. Chanel has run into some complications with the install but she is committed and continues to forge ahead. Hopefully you'll see that green menu bar soon!

Our DPLA partnership testing project is also in full swing. The review of the DPLA Exchange is complete and our test libraries have moved on to testing Circulation Manager. This phase will run through March 28, when the final patron testing phase will begin. So far, our testers have given DPLA some valuable feedback, so thank you to Embry Riddle, Prescott Public, Camp Verde Community, and Beaver Creek Libraries.

You may have noticed a few changes in Symphony. We changed the YFL library code to YCFLD, and DIAL has become TCP. There are a few more changes to come in

March. If you experience any problems, be sure to let us know.

Also, you may notice that the February numbers for OPAC searches in this report are down. Due to the Enterprise upgrade, we lost the logs from February 1 through February 17. Sorry for any inconvenience.

I've had a few requests to remind our Directors to please make an effort to send library representatives to our User Group and Committee meetings whenever possible. Everyone who attends benefits from greater participation, as it increases feedback, discussions, and both new and shared ideas, and we at the Network definitely value the feedback and information we get from these meetings.

Finally, please do look at the events listed in the following Member News section and share them with your staff and community. And remember to let us know if you've got something amazing coming up that you'd like the whole Network to know about. We're happy to share!

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# Prioritization

## Priority One: Resolve Current Helpdesk Requests

A help desk request, or work order, is the submission of a problem that one encounters during the normal operation of a YLN service. Requests are generally submitted via e-mail to help@yln.info. If a request is submitted via telephone, then a YLN staff person will create the request for the submitter. Help desk requests will always be our highest priority because in some cases a member library employee cannot complete a work function until the issue is resolved.

## Priority Two: TechLogic Contract and Purchase of AMH

Review cCreate new TechLogic contract and order an AMH for central sorting facility.

**Goal:** Create a contract for an RFID/AMH system.

**Project Lead:** Judy Poe

### Progress:

- Review contract
- Negotiate CircIT unlimited site license
- Negotiate AMH service programs/preventative maintenance contract
- Work with County attorney to draft master contract
- Combine contracts into one master contract
- Have Executive Committee review contract
- Have Steering Committee approve contract
- Negotiate with TechLogic over final contract
- Upon contract approval by both parties, order AMH
- Install AMH
- Put AMH into production

## Priority Three: YLN Strategic Plan

While the YLN has been very good about technology planning, the overall vision and strategy of the YLN has been more elusive. The Executive Committee has been working on developing a vision, mission, and strategic plan.

**Goal:** Develop a strategic plan that will bring the YLN to the year 2025.

## Priority Four: Implement BC Visibility

BlueCloud Visibility is a new product by SirsiDynix which converts our online catalog to a linked data model. This will make our records visible in search engines such as Google.

**Goal:** Implement BC Visibility

**Project Lead:** Chanel Wheeler

### Progress:

- Receive a quote from SirsiDynix
- Get approval for the purchase
- Receive an implementation plan from SD
- Offload our bibliographic database to SD to be processed.
- Test the implementation.
- Go Live
- Advertise the new service

# Prioritization

## Priority Five: Implement Blue Cloud Cataloging

Blue Cloud Cataloging will allow library staff to access Symphony cataloging from a web browser. The new product should have significant user interface improvements above the cataloging section in WorkFlows.

**Goal:** Fully implement Blue Cloud Cataloging (BCC)

**Project Lead:** Chanel Wheeler

- Upgrade Web Services so we can use BCC
- Configure Web Services for the new service
- Test BCC to see how it works
- Create documentation
- Activate it for a test library to see how it works in a production environment
- Conduct a training session for all YLN users
- Activate it for the remaining libraries
